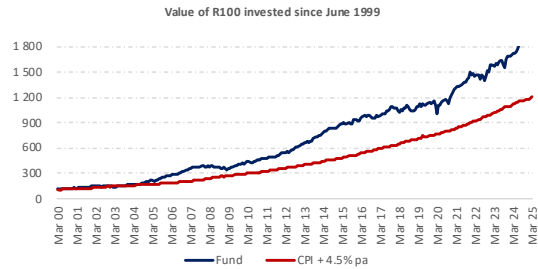
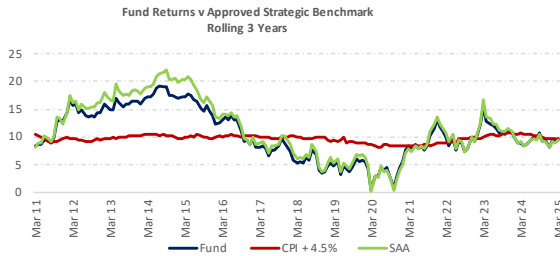


FUND OBJECTIVE

The EPPF aims to earn an annual return of at least 4.5 percent after inflation (as measured by the South African Consumer Price Index) over a rolling three-year period.
