PAYSLIPS NOW AVAILABLE ON NEW EPPF WEBSITE

Those of you who spend time online will have noticed that the EPPF recently revamped its website on www.eppf.co.za. The website now offers the convenience of accessing your pensioner payslips online. All you have to do to access your payslips is to first register on the EPPF website and then you will be able to view your payslips securely.

Other new enhancements and features on the website include:

- Resource Centre: We provide links to legislation and pension fund-related industry bodies.
- Online Contact Form: When you go to the "Contact Us" section, you can send us an email directly from the website to submit a query and we will then contact you,

Frequently Asked Questions: A general FAQ section and an FAQ section specifically for pensioners are now available on the website.

NEW ENHANCEMENTS COMING SOON

The EPPF is continuously working on making enhancements to its website. Soon you will be able to view estimates of what benefits would be payable to you by the EPPF when the main pensioner passes away. The EPPF will notify pensioners when this self-service option becomes available.

HOW TO REGISTER ON THE EPPF WEBSITE

In order to access your payslips, all you have to do is to register on the EPPF website. This is an easy process and all you have to do is follow the steps as below:

- I. Go to www.eppf.co.za .
- 2. Click on "Register" on the top right hand corner.
- 3. Type in all the mandatory fields which have an asterix.
- 4. When you fill in your pension number in the space provided, the number must be nine digits. Please add zeros at the beginning of the pension number to make up the nine digits.
- 5. Once you have completed and submitted the registration form, you will receive an email or SMS (depending on the choice you have submitted in the form) to confirm your registration.
- 6. Please keep your password safe and always use your nine-digit pension number and password to log on to your profile.

Access to your payslips is safe and secure.

TAX SEASON IS HERE

As you know tax season begins in July and lasts until November of each year. The EPPF has posted all tax certificates to pensioners during July 2014 and you should have received your tax certificate by now. If you have not received your tax certificate, you may contact the EPPF and request a duplicate certificate.

In 2013 the EPPF issued two tax certificates for the 2013 tax year, due to a new system implementation in that year. However, this year it is back to normal again and you would have received only one tax certificate.

Your tax certificates must be used for your tax submissions with the South African Revenue Service (SARS). It is your responsibility as a recipient of a pension or any form of income to ensure that your tax affairs are in order. If at the end of the tax year, it is found that you owe SARS money, please ensure that you settle the matter with SARS as soon as possible. If your tax affairs are not resolved with SARS, they may direct the EPPF to deduct the monies owed from your pension. Should this occur, the EPPF will be obliged to make such deductions, as the EPPF is legally compelled to honour any SARS directive. If you have any concerns about your tax matters, please contact your nearest SARS office or the SARS call centre on 0800 00 72 77 or visit www.sars.gov.za.

Please note that tax certificates will not be available on the EPPF website and can only be obtained by contacting the EPPF. Please visit our website on www.eppf.co.za and click on the FAQ section to view the current tax year tax tables applicable to pensioners.

DID YOU KNOW?

SPOTLIGHT ON:

DEATH BENEFITS

"Death Benefit Cover is a benefit provided by an insurer to an insured based on an insurance contract. The insurer undertakes to pay a specific amount on the occurrence of the event insured against, namely death, which can only happen once."

WHAT AND WHO IS COVERED?

The Eskom Compulsory Death Benefit will pay out the specific amount of R15 000 in the event of death of an Eskom pensioner. The policy is issued by the Eskom Captive Insurance Division with the claims administration service provided by an external service provider, which is currently Sanlam Sky.

The cover is managed by the Eskom Financial Services Department which is also responsible for facilitating the claiming process between the claimant (nominated beneficiary) and the external service provider.

WHO MAY CLAIM?

If a pensioner passes away, the deceased pensioner's nominated beneficiary may lodge a claim for payment of the death benefit in line with the terms and conditions of the cover.

HOW TO LODGE A CLAIM?

The event of the death of the main pensioner the death should be reported to the Eskom Financial Service Department as soon as possible. To avoid any possible delay in the processing and payment of the death benefit, the following original certified (certified by a Commissioner of Oaths such as a police official, magistrate, etc) must be submitted together with the completed claim form:

- Pensioner's latest pay slip;
- Death certificate;
- Deceased's ID; and
- Claimant/Beneficiary's ID.

The policy pays out within 48 hours after submission of the required information, provided that a valid claim has been proven and the submitted documents are all correct.

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE **COMPULSORY DEATH BENEFIT** & **VOLUNTARY FUNERAL SCHEME**

On 1 July 2013, Eskom changed the administrators for the Eskom Group Voluntary Funeral Scheme to Sanlam Sky. Sanlam Sky also administers the Compulsory Death Benefit claim administration and it may be difficult to distinguish between the two schemes. Let us take a look at a few differences between the Compulsory Death Benefit and the Voluntary Death Benefit.

	COMPULSORY DEATH BENEFIT	VOLUNTARY FUNERAL SCHEME
Who is the qualifying policy holder?	The main pensioner of the EPPF who retired from Eskom	Any pensioner of the EPPF (i.e. a pensioner or surviving spouse of an Eskom pensioner in receipt of a pension from EPPF)
How many people can be covered on the policy?	Only the main pensioner	The qualifying participant can include anyone in his/ her policy, provided the additional premiums are paid by the main policy holder
Can a pensioner choose whether to have the policy or not?	This is compulsory for all the main EPPF pensioners	You may choose whether to take up the policy or not
How much does the policy pay?	The benefit is currently fixed at R15 000	The policyholder may choose the amount to be payable by the policy. This will determine the premiums payable.

ABOUT LIFELONG PENSIONS

Did you know that if the main EPPF pensioner passes away and has a child who is permanently physically or mentally incapacitated, such a child can qualify for a lifelong pension on the passing of the pensioner?

What is a lifelong pension?

A lifelong pension is a pension which becomes payable to a biological or legally adopted child of the main EPPF pensioner, if such a child is permanently physically or mentally incapacitated when the pensioner passes away. The incapacity must be confirmed by medical records. The pension is payable for the lifetime of the deceased pensioner's permanently incapacitated child. An application can be made even if the child is above age 21.

When does a lifelong pension become payable?

The lifelong pension for the incapacitated child will become payable when the main EPPF pensioner passes away. The main EPPF pensioner is the former in-service member of the EPPF who retired from service and drew a pension from the EPPF. A lifelong pension can only be applied for and becomes payable to the incapacitated child only after the main EPPF pensioner had passed away.

What is the process of applying for a lifelong pension? The surviving parent or guardian of the permanently incapacitated child must complete an Application for Lifelong Pension Form. The form can be obtained from the EPPF or Eskom offices, or from the EPPF website on www.eppf.co.za. The form must be submitted to the EPPF, together with all the supporting documentation and medical records stipulated on the form. The application is then submitted and reviewed by the EPPF's Medical Panel, who will recommend the application to the Board of Trustees (the Board) of the EPPF for approval. All lifelong pension applications are subject to the approval of the Board.
